
### Primary Care AHP Ambassador Objectives






A 51 year old man presents with a 10 week history of painful right groin. He has reduced mobility, was recently diagnosed with depression and is off work.






- Exercises / self management

An 84 year old lady contacts their GP practice for home visits due to increasing falls and confusion.






- Capacity assessment






- → Sleep hygiene






## Level of expertise of Staff in AHP ARRS roles
